Wine: Alvarino or Albarino is a variety of white wine most commonly grown in North-Western Spain and Galacia. It is thought the Grape Variety is closely related to Riesling and Petit Manseng, both high in aromatics and retaining acidity for agreeability, important for making fine white wines.

Vinification: Hand-Picked, whole-bunch pressed and fermented in stainless steel, to ensure finesse, freshness and balance.

Tasting notes: Expect notes of lemon, lime, grapefruit and pear. The palate is composed, a lovely mix of citrus, herbs and savory accents. To finish, a tangy tail of acidity sweeps through.
